

POLICY: STUDENT VEHICLES/ MOTORBIKES

Rationale

The parking of cars and motorbikes on school grounds is a privilege granted by the Principal. The safety of students and staff demands that strict guidelines are observed regarding the use of such vehicles and motorbikes.

Purposes

1. To ensure the safety of students, staff and the general public.
2. To ensure students represent the school in an acceptable manner while they are in control of the said vehicle/ motorbike while arriving and leaving school.
3. To ensure vehicles/motorbikes are road compliant if parked on school grounds.

Guidelines

1. Parents/ Caregivers/ Guardians must request permission in writing for their son/daughter to park a vehicle/ motorbike at school.
2. Disciplinary action (eg. removal of the parking permit) may be instituted by the school if any of the above conditions are broken by a student.
6. The school will pass on formal complaints to the Police where students who are identifiable as Rotorua Lakes High School students, commit an offence while in charge of a vehicle/motorbike.
